

## **Booster Meeting Minutes – 07/11/2017**

**Meeting was called to order by Michael Glidewell at 6:30 P.M.**

### **Old Business:**

#### **Michael Glidewell**

- The menu for band camp will be posted on the FB page and a Google form will be sent out for the students to sign up for a meal. All meals are free and will come with water, chips, cookies/brownie and fresh fruit. There will be Powerade/Gatorade available to purchase for a \$1.00. We will need volunteers to help prepare the meals, serve the students and to send cookies, brownies and/or fresh fruit.
- The new delivery date for the new uniforms is now August 8<sup>th</sup>. The original delivery date was August 25. All students and parents will have to sign a usage agreement.

### **New Business:**

#### **Sid Brown time**

- We are still allowing students to sign up for the New York/Philly trip. The last day to sign up to go on the trip will be the first week in August. The total cost of the trip is \$825.00. We are chartering three buses and at this time we still have 30-35 seats available. We must have 100 members going in order to march in the parade. The parade will be nationally televised.
- We have two carts that need to be refurbished for percussion instruments and a rolling keyboard/mixer rack built. Lee Stanley is working on the carts for the speakers. If anyone can help, please let Sid know.
- We purchased three block rockers for the auxiliary to play their music on during rehearsal. We need to find someone who can wire all three of them together.
- The bidding process on the new instruments cut the cost of the instruments down. Out of the \$20,000.00 we still have around \$2,500.00 to purchase a keyboard and microphones for the sidelines. We are hoping that the new instruments get here before band camp begins.
- We will have a mass band meeting on at 6:00 P.M Thursday, July 13 for all band members in the high school lunchroom. This meeting will help prepare the rookies for band camp. The first week of band camp, July 17-21, rookies will meet from 8:00 A.M –noon and full band will meet

from 1:00 A.M - 5:00 P.M. The second week, July 24-28, the full band will meet from 8:00 A.M - 5:00 P.M. Fridays will be ½ days. On Friday, July 28, we will have a pool party at Camp World Song from 6:00 P.M – 9:00 P.M. Hot dogs and/or hamburgers will be provided at the party.

- After school practice will be on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays of each week from 3:00 P.M – 5:00 or 5:30 P.M.
- The band pictures will be Monday, July 31 at 8:00 A.M. We will have to have them made in the old uniforms in order to have pictures for the football program. We will schedule a later date once our new uniforms are in to remake the pictures.
- We still need input on a new band logo.
- We need someone to volunteer to pressure wash the concrete in front of the band hall.
- We are in the process of cleaning out the dressing rooms. Goodgame is painting both dressing rooms, putting in ceiling tiles and replacing the lights. The girl's dressing room will also have tables and stools for the girls to get ready and benches for them to sit on. Corey advised that we may have stools we can use upstairs in the band hall, rather than purchasing new ones. Lisa advised that she has piano tables in her classroom that can be used instead of us building them.
- The school will be putting locks on the bathroom stalls in the band hall and will be stripping and waxing the floors.
- Family night is scheduled for August 25. This night is for family and friends to come and see our show.
- The St. Clair County Expo will be at Ragland High School on September 19. Ragland will also host the Honor Band in the spring.
- We will have forms at the meeting on July 13 for those interested in purchasing ads for the football program.

#### **Corey Funderburg time**

- If possible, could the Boosters provide more than crackers to the Jr. High band when they play at the Jr. High games. Could we possibly serve them more of a meal?

#### **Megan/Lisa/Shelby time**

- The boosters will be paying for the silks being purchased this season, since auxiliary reimbursed them for the loan made to the Winterguard in December.
- The auxiliary may need the booster's assistance in purchasing one of the auxiliary outfits, this will be a loan. The board met and agreed that the boosters will loan the auxiliary \$1,200.00 for

the outfits, with the understanding that the boosters will be reimbursed when each auxiliary make their initial payment of \$150.00.

- We are still working on our annual sponsorship. We have to have all checks in from the sponsors by July 21 in order to get our band t-shirts bank in time for the first football game. Megan is getting with someone at Royal Sausage to see if they will provide the boosters with hotdogs for the season.
